Procedure 3515P, Student Incentives

Revisions are requested by Dani Mundell and recommended by legal counsel. This year several schools had planned to purchase incentives to provide to students. For example, the coaches union negotiated for each middle and high school to receive \$5000 of ESSER funding to aid in the re-engagement and recruitment for athletics and activities. Another request is to purchase t-shirts to be randomly and equitably distributed during basketball games to encourage both student attendance and good sportsmanship. It was discovered the amount the school wanted to spend exceeded the current dollar amount provided for in Procedure 3515P. With Covid ruling out some ideas for the ESSER money, schools are looking to use this money more on incentives to get students out to events and a part of programs whether they be a participant or spectator. This revision would add language to allow the superintendent to preapprove a higher limit for student incentives.
