What are the 5 High School & Beyond Plan tasks all seniors must complete for graduation?	According to Washington State, seniors need to complete the following to meet their High School & Beyond Plan: Career Interest Profiler Survey (Naviance) Financial Aid Survey (Naviance) Upload Final Resume (Naviance) High School & Beyond Plan Spring Senior Survey (Naviance) Upload Documentation of a Post-secondary Plan (Naviance)	
Why and what are these 5 key HBP tasks?	 Career Interest Profiler – All students need to complete a career interest survey prior to graduation to help them discover possible future options and explore education and/or training to develop a plan to achieve their goals. Financial Aid Survey – Ideally, it would be great to have all students complete a financial aid application (FAFSA/WASFA) to discover options for funding future education and/or training, the financial aid survey documents that students were informed about financial aid, and they can indicate their choice to apply or not apply. Upload Final Resume – Students can utilize the Resume Builder tool in Naviance to create a resume or use a resume they have already created. Once they have a complete resume, they will upload it to the corresponding task in Naviance. Having a final resume provides seniors the opportunity to prepare for their post-secondary options. High School & Beyond Plan Spring Senior Survey – The HSBP survey provides the seniors with the opportunity to indicate their post-secondary plans, identify how they are meeting the Washington State Graduation Pathways in ELA and Math, and provide feedback on their overall high school experience. Even if they completed the fall HSBP survey, all seniors need to complete the spring survey to provide updated information on their post-secondary "next steps". Documentation of Post-secondary Plan – Based on the post-secondary option students choose in their spring HSBP survey, they will need to upload a corresponding piece of documentation. Examples include but are not limited to-screenshot of an acceptance email to a college or 	
What is the difference between completing the semester long CCRS class and a CCRS course equivalency when it comes to the HSBP?	 training program, correspondence with a military recruiter, document explaining their plans to take a gap year, correspondence with their employer if continuing etc. Seniors typically complete the College & Career Readiness Seminar (CCRS) or a course equivalency in their senior year of high school. CCRS is a semester long course where students complete specific tasks in Naviance (including the five state requirements) and an online financial literacy course called EverFi. When both are complete, students get a .5 CTE credit and their High School & Beyond Plan gets marked as MET on their transcript. Students in a CCRS course equivalency have the entire school year to complete the Naviance tasks (including the five state requirements) and have the option to complete the EverFi online financial literacy course. When the Naviance tasks are complete, students' High School & Beyond Plan gets marked as MET on their transcript.
