RESOLUTION NO. 1274**

Declaration of Sole Source Bales Restoration

WHEREAS, Everett School District is a duly constituted School District organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has the requirement to protect taxpayer investment in buildings and grounds; and

WHEREAS, school districts in the State of Washington are authorized by RCW 39.04.280, to waive competitive bidding requirement in specific situations; and

WHEREAS, an emergent need for water remediation and intervention services occurred at both Gateway Middle School and Henry M. Jackson High School when water coils burst, flooding classroom and gymnasium areas; and

WHEREAS, Bales Restoration was identified as providing the restoration services that met or exceeded the District's needs; and

WHEREAS, Bales Restoration is a certified provider who had the immediate availability and qualifications to provide the necessary services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington agrees as follows:


That the requirement by the Administration for immediate water remediation and intervention services at Gateway Middle and Henry M. Jackson High Schools was necessary to avoid further and more costly damage to the school buildings and facilities.

That the purchase is clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply, in accordance with RCW 39.04.280.

That the competitive bidding requirements of RCW 28A.335.190 are hereby waived in the presence of a documented single source of supply.

Adopted by the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, held on May 10, 2022.


