**RESOLUTION NO. 1275**

Increase of Appropriation in Capital Projects Fund

**WHEREAS**, Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, is a first-class school district duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and the laws of the state of Washington; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 28A.505.170 and WAC 392-123-071 provide for a first-class school district to extend its budget for any fund; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 8, 2022, the voters of the Everett School District approved a 6-year replacement capital levy of \$325,500,000.00, and

**WHEREAS**, the district desires to begin planning and design services for the Jackson Elementary School Replacement, Security Fencing at Cascade and Everett High Schools, H.M. Jackson High School Clean Buildings Act Project, which are part of the newly approved 2022 capital levy; and, having the need and capacity, to accelerate the District Wide Security Camera Replacement project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Capital Projects Fund of Everett School District No. 2 has additional expenditures in the 2021-22 school year as a result of the projects listed above, which will require an increase in appropriation of \$4,000,000.00; and


**WHEREAS**, the Capital Projects Fund beginning fund balance plus anticipated revenues is sufficient to provide for the additional expenditures.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors of Everett Public Schools hereby petition the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) to increase the 2021-22 Capital Projects Fund appropriation amount from \$25,483,252 to \$29,483,252. Pursuant to WAC 392-123-071, the Superintendent shall promptly file two copies of this signed Resolution with the Educational Service District 189.


