Jackson High's robotics team ranked 2nd in world competition

Team 2910 Jack in the Bot competed in premiere off-season FIRST Robotics event



Mill Creek, WA—Sept. 24, Henry M. Jackson High School's Team 2910 - Jack in the Bot traveled to San Jose, CA to compete at a premiere off-season *FIRST Robotics* invitational event, <u>Chezy Champs</u>, against 38 teams from around the world. Over the qualification matches they clawed their way to the #2 ranking robot securing a position in the elimination rounds as the #2 ranked alliance captain.

Moving into a double elimination bracket, and suffering an early loss, they again won enough matches to make the finals. These eliminations rounds featured some of the most competitive gameplay of the past year in *FIRST Robotics*. Opponents were heavily decorated with several World Championship appearances and wins, however, Team 2910 battled and placed second in the championship event.

"Although we fell just short of winning the competition, we are very proud to be bringing home a Finalists Award from one of the most competitive off-season robotics events in the world!" shared Alison Kim, Team 2910 media officer.

They are truly awesome kids to work with and I'm excited for what I know they can accomplish in the upcoming 2022-2023 Robotics Season," added Team 2910 Coach Kyle Pihl.
