



Adding world language characters to Chrome OS


Languages that will need a keyboard activated: Amharic, Arabic, Armenian, Cantonese, Chinese (Mandarin) Simplified & Traditional, Hebrew, Hindi, Japanese, Korean, Marathi, Russian, Tamil, Telugu, Vietnamese, and Urdu

Some language keyboards use characters that are not in Chrome OS. You can load these easily.

1. Click on the three-dot menu and select settings.



2. Click on advanced to open the advanced setting menu





3. Click on language to open the menu




4. Click add languages



5. Search or scroll to the language you want to load. Check the box for that

language, then click add.
