<p>What academic needs your student may have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increase rigor to ensure readiness for next level (middle school, high school, college and career)</li><li>• If a student has behavior/social needs, the focus on academics needs to continue</li><li>• Students need teachers to check for understanding more often; students don't always know how to ask for help</li></ul>	<p>We will continue to grow each school's routines to ensure that families are centered in our daily work, as partners, to support student achievement.</p> <p>Each school will be working on individualized follow up plans based on the feedback they heard from their specific school.</p>
