## **Legislative Representative**

The legislative representative shall serve as the board's liaison to the Washington State School Directors' Association (WSSDA) on legislative issues. The legislative representative shall be elected from among the board members following the reorganizational meeting in an even year for a two-year (2) period. The legislative representative, board chair/president, or other board designee shall represent the board at WSSDA's Legislative General Assembly, conveying local views and concerns to that body. and, when When appropriate, the legislative representative obtaining obtains the board's support for a legislative proposal to be submitted to the Assembly and supporting it at the Assembly. The legislative representative and appropriate staff shall monitor proposed school legislation and provide legislative updates periodically at board meetings. Additionally, he/she the legislative representative will build relationships with local policy makers regarding WSSDA's legislative positions and priorities.
