CTSO/CTE Club Advisors ONLY **CTSO/CTE Club ADDITIONAL SUPPORT**

The CTSO/CTE Club Additional Support is designed to support CTSO/CTE Clubs with expenses that are not fully funded by CTE. Requests should be made after the number of participants have been designated and the total cost has been determined.

EXAMPLES:

15 JHS FBLA students has qualified for State based off of regional competition. The total hotel cost is \$2,000.00. FBLA has 50 affiliated members which equals \$2,500.00 in ADDITIONAL SUPPORT. JHS FBLA requests ADDITIONAL SUPPORT of \$2,000.00 to cover the hotel costs.

CHS FCCLA has 5 students registered to attend the FCCLA Spring Conference. The conference registration is \$20.00 per student. The conference is non-competitive, so the students are responsible for the registration cost as per the [2022 – 2023 CTSO Advisor Guide](#). CHS FFCLA has 10 members which equals \$500.00 in additional funding. The request ADDITIONAL SUPPORT of \$100.00 (5*\$20.00 each) to pay for the registration cost.

Please note that ADDITIONAL SUPPORT will be based on November 1 affiliation (membership) totals.

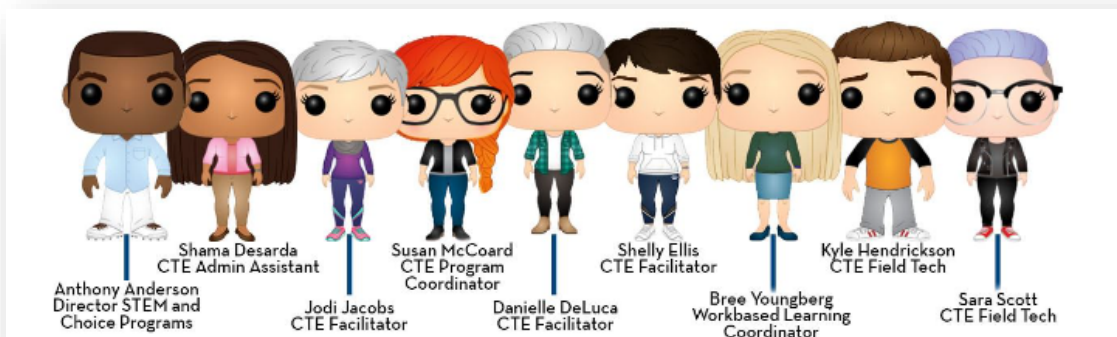
