# **Policy 2409** Granting Equivalency Credit

Revisions remove language that is no longer current or in practice.

## Policy 2410 and Procedure 2410P High School Graduation Requirements

Revisions include the addition of language regarding Graduation Requirements Emergency Waiver (GREW). In July 2021 the State Board of Education (SBE) passed permanent rules allowing districts to offer waivers of certain graduation requirements on an individual student basis during certain emergencies, including the current COVID-19 public health crisis. The current GREW rules permit the waiver of up to 2.0 core or flexible credits and/or the graduation pathway requirements for students in the classes of 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023 as described in <a href="Chapter 180-111 WAC">Chapter 180-111 WAC</a>. Revisions also update graduation requirements through the class of 2027 and removes language no longer current.

### Policy 2416 High School Equivalency Certificate

This new policy reflects current regulations regarding eligibility requirements for individuals to take the high school equivalency test found in <u>WAC 131-48-100</u> and provides clarification that the application and decision process for determining whether an individual has a substantial and warranted reason for leaving the regular high school program found as prescribed in <u>WAC 180-96-045</u> and <u>WAC 180-96-048</u>.

## **Procedure 5225P** Technology

Revisions include the addition of language stating staff will not alter the physical hardware of district computers. This language is already provided in student technology procedure 3245P.

#### Policy 6959 Release of Retainage on Completed Construction Projects

Revisions include the deletion of this policy. The policy language, which is more procedural in nature, will be moved to **Procedure 6950P**, Public Works Contractor Assurances and Change Orders.
