What is Youth Re-Engagement?

An Open Doors program located at Everett Community College designed to help disengaged or credit-deficient high school students reengage in their education.

Students can earn one or more of the following for **FREE**:

- High School Diploma
- GED
- Vocational Certificate
- Associate Degree

Youth Re-Engagement pays for your tuition, books, and required supplies. Students are also provided support from a case manager and have access to other resources through the college.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ◆ 16-21 years old (must be 16 and not yet 21 by September 1st of current school year)
- ◆ Significantly behind in credits or not enrolled in school
- ◆ Live in the Everett Public Schools service area

How To Enroll:

- ◆ Get referred by your counselor or a school staff member directly. Students who are new to Everett Public Schools will need to enroll at their resident high school and meet with a counselor, success coordinator, or admin to be referred.
- ◆ Attend an information session (dates/times available on the website). Call 425-259-8738 to schedule.
- ◆ Complete and submit an application.
- ◆ Receive an invitation to attend orientation. During orientation you will learn more about the program options and take a standardized placement test.
- ◆ Schedule an interview appointment with a case manager to discuss your learning preferences, educational goals, and past obstacles, and work with your case manager to create your plan.
