## Dutside Agency Counseling Sessions at School

If you receive a request to have a mental health therapist work with one of your students during the school day, please check the list below for agencies who have a current MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) on file with Everett Public School for the 2022-23 school year.

If you don't see the agency of the therapist your student is working with on this list, please reach out to me (Dave Peters) to get the process started (or for a status update if it's in progress).

Below is the background information:

Occasionally requests are made for counselors/therapists from outside agencies to meet with students at school during the school day. These arrangements can be permitted *if* the following considerations are in place in advance:

- 1. Meeting with the student outside the school day would be prohibitive for the parent or guardian due to work schedules, transportation barriers, etc. (i.e. equitable access)
- 2. A confidential meeting space is available, and the school principal gives approval
- 3. Prior to outside counseling sessions with students at school, in person, or on zoom, an MOU is signed between the agency/counselor and the district
  - a. The agency or school counselor may contact Dave Peters to start this process
  - b. The MOU templates for 2022-23 are ready and available
