RESOLUTION NO. 1290

PREPARATONS FOR A REDUCTION OF THE 2023-24 OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS, the District's projected 2023-24 student enrollment is projected to experience a slight decline from the 2022-23 enrollment; and

WHEREAS, the District's regionalization factor decreased through 2023-24 and the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Funds are non-recurring federal funds; and

WHEREAS, The District does not have the presently assured financial resources to maintain its program and services at the present levels for the 2023-24 fiscal year, it is necessary to make certain reductions in the District's educational program, including reductions in certificated, classified, and administrative positions for 2023-24 school year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Everett Public Schools:

- 1. The Superintendent is directed to develop a reduction plan for 2023-24, with the goal of reducing expenditures to the level of reasonably anticipated revenues; and
- 2. The Superintendent is directed to present such plan for review and action by the Board at its February 28, 2023, special board meeting.
