Everett, WA— Each year, AAA Washington recognizes one advisors' contribution to Patrollers' safety and education. This year's recipient is Andrea Rosen from Forest View Elementary School for her innovative approach to promoting safety and reinforcing traffic safety principles.

Rosen said she was surprised when she learned she had been selected as the 2023 AAA Safety Patrol Advisor of the Year, but she shouldn't have been! In five of the six years she has been an advisor, she has had a student inducted into the AAA School Safety Patrol Hall of Fame.

"Andrea has gone above and beyond her responsibilities as an advisor by helping bring important safety initiatives to fruition," said Erin Rogers, community relations program manager at AAA

Washington. "Andrea's efforts have fostered a safer school environment and inspired a new generation of young leaders who actively advocate for safer communities."

This years' 2023 AAA School Safety Patrol Hall of Fame inductee is Forest View Elementary fifth grader Ivory Ware. A panel of judges from AAA Washington, the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (WTSC), the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) and a regional representative for the National Highway Transportation Safety Administration (NHTSA) chose these ten outstanding patrollers from 41 candidates.

"I've being able to watch her confidence blossom into a model student to all kids at Forest View and one the staff can count on to do the right thing at all times," said advisor Andrea Rosen. "Ivory can be observed telling her fifth grade peers to walk in the hall along with supporting her classmates with work they might not understand."
