Everett Public Schools offers jobs on-the-spot at job fair

More than 120 people attend job fair and 43 walk away with jobs



Everett, WA— After a successful inaugural fair last summer, Everett Public Schools (EPS) hosted its second annual job fair on Tuesday, August 8 from 3-7 p.m. at the Community Resource Center.

This year, the district had over 120 applicants attend the job fair, with 43 job seekers offered positions by the end of the event. There were 38 applicants who expressed interest in being placed in the classified substitution pool as well.

On-site individualized support was available from 1-3 p.m. from our Employment Services team including help creating a resume and cover letter. There were interpreters available for Spanish, Arabic, Russian and Ukrainian speaking attendees.

Every school and department that had open positions were there to interview the applicants and for some, offer positions on the spot. For those who were offered positions, they were able to go to Human Resources and complete paperwork to expedite the hiring process.

EPS is striving to recruit and retain a more diverse workforce to support our students and families and is being intentional in connecting and creating partnerships with our community allies across Everett and Snohomish County about employment opportunities in our district.

“The job fair was an amazing success,” stated Chad Golden, executive director of human resources. “It took a lot of teamwork to pull it off, but it was so worth it. We were able to attract a diverse group of applicants and help them navigate a system that can be challenging. In the end we were able to hire some great people and expand our classified substitute pool to help cover when staff are out.”

There are still some open positions for those who are interested in EPS. It is a great place to work with 18 elementary, five middle and four high schools and more than 2,200 staff members. Our 20,000+ students speak more than 90 different languages.
