School Drill Requirements

Schools must conduct at least one safety-related drill per month. Drills must practice four functional threat responses:

- 1. **Shelter-in-place (1)** used to limit the exposure of students and staff to hazardous materials, such as chemical, biological, or radiological contaminants, released into the environment from the outside;
- 2. **Lockdown (1)** used to isolate students and staff from threats of violence, such as suspicious trespassers or armed intruders, that may occur in a school or in the vicinity of a school;
- Fire Evacuation (2) used to move students and staff away from threats, such as fires, oil train spills, or tsunamis; and
- 4. **Earthquake drill (2)** using the state-approved earthquake safety technique "drop, cover, and hold must be conducted;" If you would like to participate, the Great American Shakeout is: October 15, 2020

The drills described above must incorporate the following requirements:

- 1. The first evacuation drill must be completed **on or before February 5. 2021**. If possible, please do not wait until the last day.
- 2. At least **one** safety-related drill must use the **school mapping information system** (Safety Center);
- 3. The **Rave Panic Button** app must be used in at least **one** safety-related drills. Planned use of the app during a drill must be **prearranged with the Snohomish County 911 duty shift supervisor**. Please **call 425-407-3930** to inform the duty shift supervisor of the date and time you are planning a drill using the Rave Panic Button app.
