Be honest with yourself, there are no right or wrong answers.

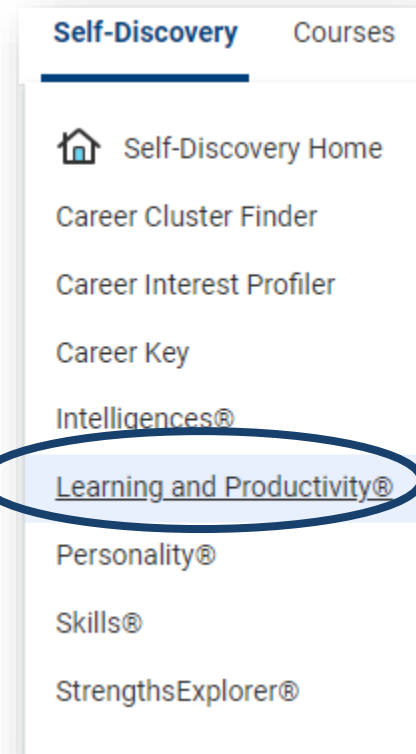

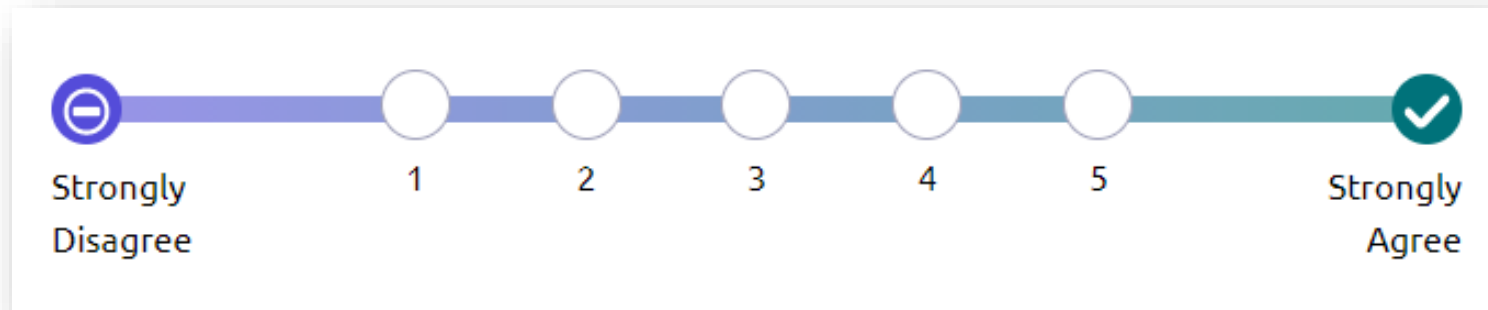


# Check out each statement

For each statement, you will select a number on a scale between 1 and 5.

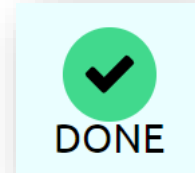
**1** = Strongly Disagree

Your preferences are grouped into the categories of **sensory**, **environmental**, and **mindset**.

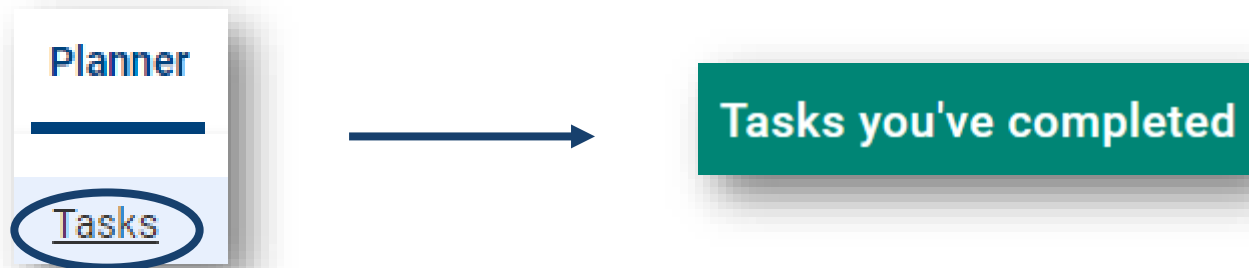
- Each preferences has a subsection with more information about how you work and learn
