Students apply in the fall of the year prior to when they would like to attend.</p> <p>Running Start – A program through Washington community and technical colleges allowing 11th & 12th grade students to take college courses earning both high school and college credits at the same time.</p> <p>College in the High School – A program offering high school students the opportunity to earn both high school and college credit at the same time for advanced, college-level coursework through their high school class.</p>
