
What is a G. P. A.?

2. How do I calculate my GPA?	Starting in middle school, you will receive a letter grade for each class based on your academic performance. Each letter grade is worth a set number. You add up each number and divide by the total number of classes to get the average.
3. Here is an example of the GPA scale and how you would calculate a GPA: A 4.0 A-3.7 B+3.3 B 3.0 B-2.7 C+2.3 C 2.0 C-1.7 D+1.3 D 1.0 D-0.7 F 0.0	The average number is your GPA. If you had the following grades, your GPA would be 3.04. Add up each point value for the letter grade and divide by 6. Class Grade English A Math B+ Science B Choir C+ P.E. C History A-
