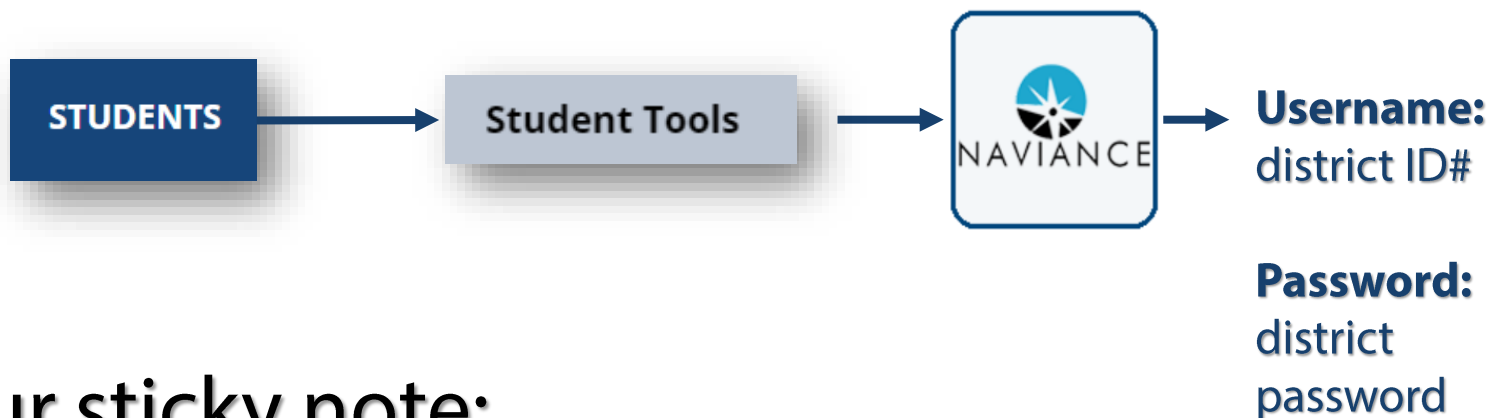

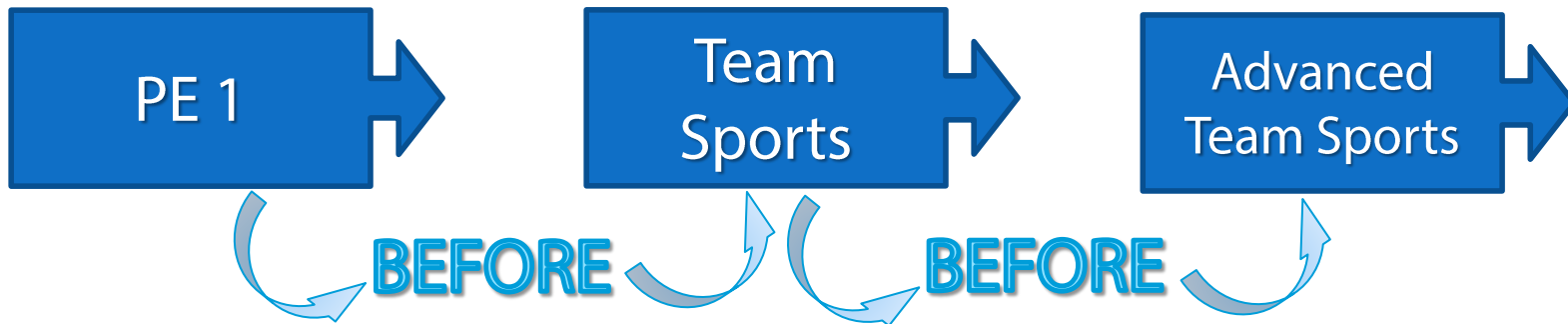

GPA

Based on the grades you earn each semester, your GPA or *Grade Point Average* is calculated.

This number indicates the average of the grades you receive

*Most schools use a point system from 0-4.

A	=	4.0 points
A-	=	3.7 points
B+	=	3.3 points
B	=	3.0 points
B-	=	2.7 points
C+	=	2.3 points
C	=	2.0 points
C-	=	1.7 points
D	=	1.0 points
F	=	0.0 points

Credit

For each class you pass per semester you receive 0.5 credit.



*In high school, you will need **24** credits total in 4-years to graduate.

MS for HS Credit

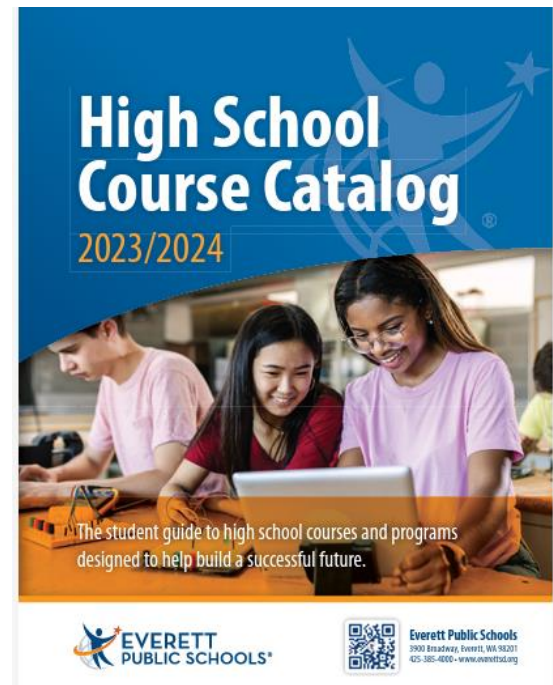
Students can take middle school courses for high school credit. After the first semester of high school, these courses will appear on the official transcript.

Advanced Placement (AP)

Many colleges will award credit or waive requirements for demonstrated proficiency through the AP exams.

Students can begin taking AP courses as early as 9th grade.

College partners offering credit choices are:

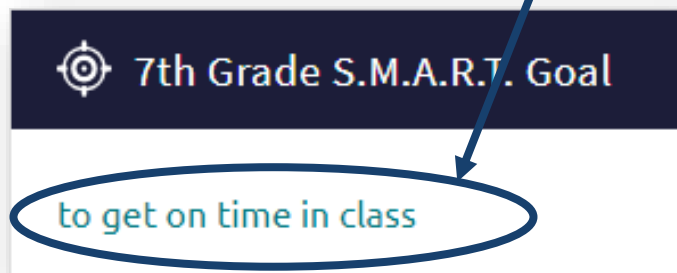

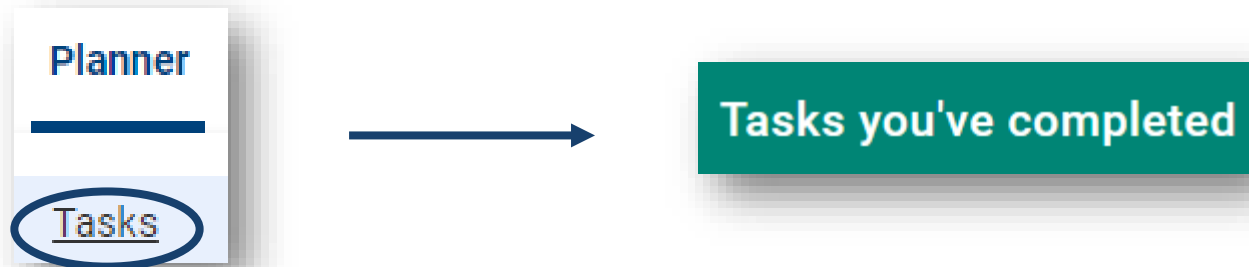
