## **SBA: English Language Arts Cohort Trend**




#### SBA Mathematics Trends 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade


#### SBA Mathematics Trends 4th Grade






#### **WCAS Science Trends: All Grades**








## Percent of Multilingual Learners (ML) Proficient and Progressing WIDA Access






## Multilingual Learners (ML) Percent Progressing Washington State and Everett Public Schools WIDA Access






## Smarter Balanced ELA Grade 3 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced ELA Grade 4 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced ELA Grade 5 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced ELA Grade 6 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced ELA Grade 7 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status












## Smarter Balanced Math Grade 3 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced Math Grade 4 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced Math Grade 5 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced Math Grade 6 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced Math Grade 7 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## Smarter Balanced Math Grade 8 Percent Proficient by Level of Tested Ranked by October 2024 Socio-economic Status






## School Percent by Level Tested Science


