UTILITY ASSISTANCE

 - Once per year assistance for Everett Utility customers who have received a water shutoff notice and are at 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. If you receive a senior or disabled discount from Everett Utilities, you are not eligible.

- **Project Pride - St. Vincent de Paul North Sound Council**
 - One time grant for families whose income is less than 150% of the federal poverty guidelines
 - Must have a notice of disconnection of service
