TRAINING PLAN?

Yes!

Per OSPI, all CTE Conditionally Certified teachers must have a training plan on file for each two-year period of their conditional certificate.





WHY DO I NEED ONE?

CTE conditional certificates are technically temporary certs, requiring renewal every two years. The state requires that we ensure our teachers complete job relevant professional development throughout those two years to stay on top of teaching and industry knowledge.

WHAT COUNTS AS PD?

Any job relevant PD offered by Everett Public Schools counts, CTE courses taken at any college/university/community college, hours participating on your Program Advisory Council, and hours spent (and tracked) working on frameworks can count.
