#### **GRADUATION UPDATE: CLASS OF 2024 AND PREVIEW OF SUMMER GRADUATION**

The board was provided <u>an update</u> on the class of 2024 and summer graduation. Commencement ceremonies for students in the class of 2024 were held on June 13 for Sequoia High School and June 15 for Everett High School, Cascade High School, and Henry M. Jackson High School. Each high school engaged students in preparation for graduation and to ensure each senior makes necessary progress toward on-time graduation and college- and career-readiness for graduation in June or for the August 15 summer commencement ceremony. The board will hear a status report on the class of 2024 with specific information about strategies and interventions to help students meet graduation requirements and how school staff are implementing emergency waivers of graduation requirements for students in this class who have demonstrated post-secondary readiness.

#### THIRD QUARTER FINANCIAL REPORT

The board of directors heard <u>a report</u> on third quarter financials. Monthly budget status reports for each fund were provided to the board to include the most current fiscal activity by summary accounts in state form F-198. In addition to this required document, the finance department provides more detailed information on general fund (operating fund) year-to-date expenditure and revenue activity, a projected ending fund balance, a cash at County report, and an investment summary. This information is summarized in a third quarter and May 2024 financial presentation, based upon the companion consent agenda item, Acceptance of the Financial Reports as of May 31, 2024.
