PREPARATIONS FOR A REDUCTION OF THE 2024-25 OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS, the District's anticipated 2024-25 expenditures are projected to exceed revenues; and

WHEREAS, as a cautionary measure, to ensure the District will continue to maintain its financial resources and maintain its programs and services at the present levels for the 2024-25 fiscal year, it is necessary to make certain reductions in the District's educational program, including reductions in certificated, classified, and administrative positions for the 2024-25 school year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Everett Public Schools:

- 1. The Superintendent is directed to develop a reduction plan for 2024-25, with the goal of reducing expenditures to the level of reasonably anticipated revenues; and
- 2. The Superintendent is directed to present such plan for review and action by the Board at its April 23, 2024 regular board meeting.
