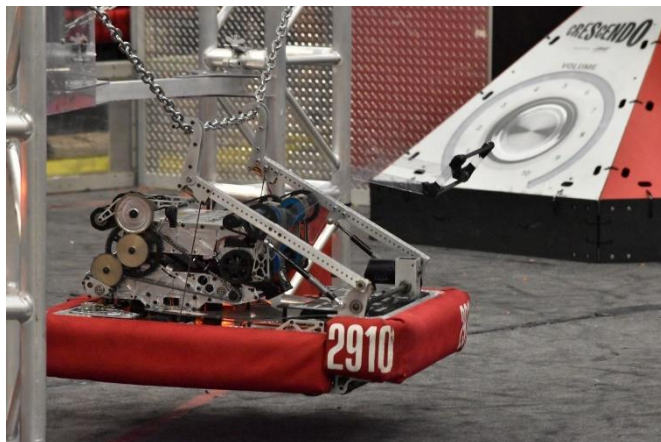
Henry M. Jackson High School robotics team wins Chezy Champs

Team 2910: Jack in the Bot achieves historic win at prestigious robotics competition

Mill Creek, WA — Henry M. Jackson High School's robotics team, [Team 2910: Jack in the Bot](#), claimed its first-ever victory at the Chezy Champs competition, held September 27-29, 2024, in San Jose, California. This prestigious win marks the first time a team has won both Chezy Champs and the Indiana Robotics Invitational (IRI) in the same year.



Jack in the Bot finished the qualification rounds undefeated with a 10-0 record, securing the top seed and forming a powerhouse alliance with Team 6328 (Mechanical Advantage), Team 670 (Homestead Robotics), and Team 5199 (Robot Dolphins From Outer Space). The team advanced through challenging double-elimination playoffs, winning the finals in a thrilling best-of-three series to bring home the championship banner.



Robot driver Sudhir Chebiyyam praised the experience, saying, "We are grateful to have had the opportunity to compete at Chezy Champs this year, and it was really exciting to be able to compete among the many amazing teams that showed up. Thanks to the diligent work of our scouting, drive, and strategy teams, we earned the number one seed, allowing us to build a world-class alliance with whom we won the event. Team 2910 will compete next at Washington Girls Generation, hosted by Bear Metal (Team 2046) on October 12-13 at Tahoma Senior High School, Maple Valley. The event is free and open to the public.
