






Graduation Rates, Classes of 2011 – 2024

Washington State Postsecondary Outcomes



90%

Around **90%** of surveyed high school students in Washington say they want to pursue education after graduation.

52%

Just **52%** of Washington students enroll in a postsecondary program after high school – lower than the national average of 62%.

42nd

Our state ranks **42nd** in FAFSA completion, the form to receive federal financial aid.

Just **48%** of students completed the FAFSA in Washington in 2024.






Postsecondary Enrollment Rates






In-State and Out-of-State Postsecondary Enrollment






Postsecondary Enrollment by Institution Type

Guaranteed Admission Program



- District participation in the Guaranteed Admission Program (GAP) is in its third year
- Eight institutions "guarantee" admission for seniors with a GPA of 3.0 or higher (3.3 for Pacific Lutheran University) and who are on track to meet the necessary College Academic Distribution Requirements (CADR) courses needed for college entrance
- In September, 542 seniors were identified as GAP eligible (439 for Pacific Lutheran University) and will be receiving acceptance notifications in early October

- Everett Reengagement Academy and Everett Virtual Academy and Participation in Graduation Ceremonies – <u>2410P</u>

Students enrolled in Everett Reengagement Academy and Everett Virtual Academy are eligible to participate in the Everett Public Schools summer graduation ceremony upon successful completion of all graduation requirements. For students enrolled in Everett Reengagement Academy and Everett Virtual Academy to be eligible to participate in a graduation ceremony at Cascade High School, Everett High School, H.M. Jackson High School, or Sequoia High School, the student must be enrolled in the respective school by the first day of second semester of the school year in which the student will graduate. In addition, the student must remain enrolled at the school through the end of the semester, must earn a minimum of 3.0 credits at the school during the second semester of the year in which the student will graduate, and meet all other graduation requirements.
