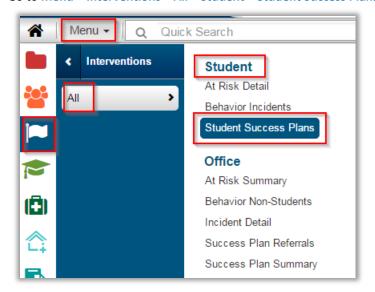

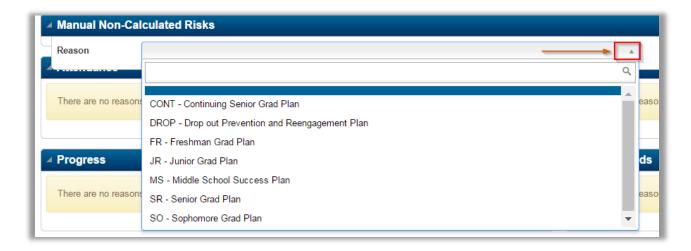
- 1. Find the student.

3. Click on the "+" sign across from the "Manual Non-Calculated Risks".

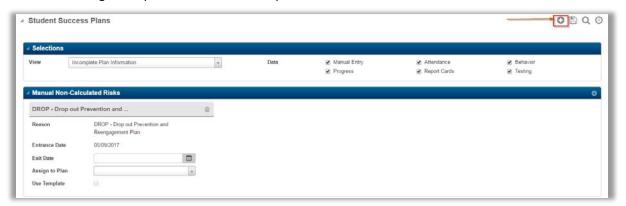


4. Select the reason "DROP" for the plan by clicking on the arrow.

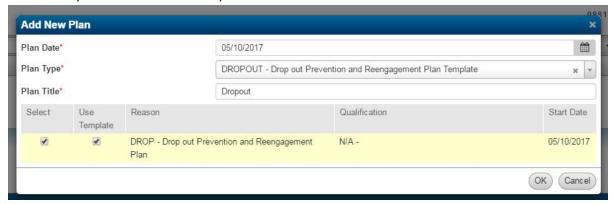

- 6. Click on the "+" sign on top of the screen to add a plan.

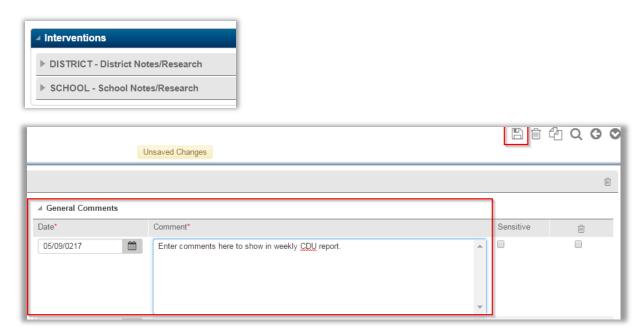
