

Setting up Wake-Up Calls

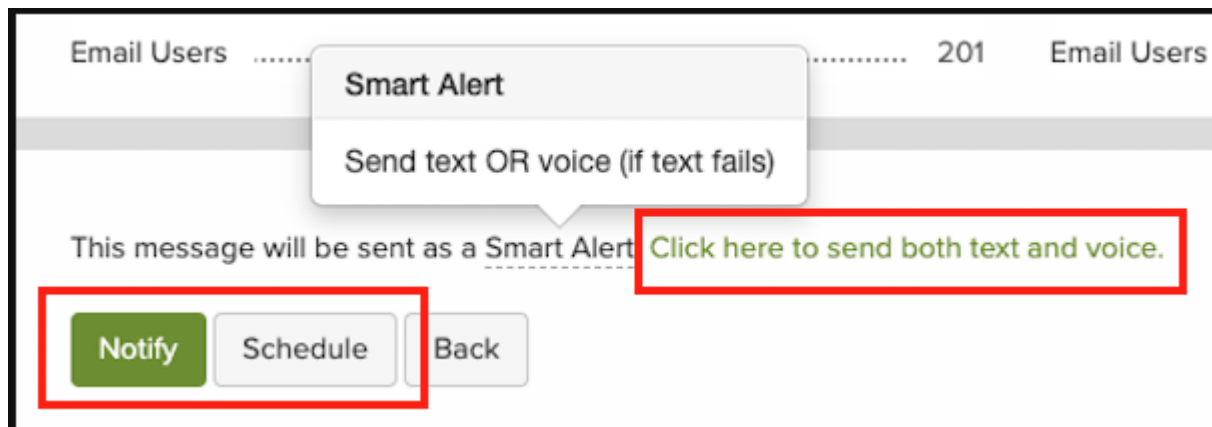
(it's not as easy as with BlackBoard)

ParentSquare suggests creating a group with all students who should receive a wake-up call.

Then, set up a smart alert.

To send only a voice call, unclick "text" and "email" and activate the voicemail feature by checking that box. (The system will read anything written in the text box (robot voice), or you can record a message or upload an audio file.)

You can schedule the message (only one day and time).



Then, that message will be in your alerts and notices list. Click the three dots by that message and replicate it. Then, set it up with your Wake-Up Call group and schedule it. Repeat as necessary.

(NOTE: I asked them to send their programmers a note to consider including the plus button like BlackBoard had.)
