Bathroom Passes

from Sechin's Dec 16 Monday Message

We're still seeing the escalation of groups of students out of classrooms. As always, please stick to these guidelines:

- Require students to check in to class to get a pass before going to the bathroom. Let them know if they go to the bathroom before coming to class, they're tardy!
- Except in an emergency, avoid letting students take the pass during the first and last 5 minutes of class.
- Do not send multiple kids out with a single pass.
- If you suspect someone is abusing the pass (taking it every day, being gone for long periods of time), have a conversation with the student, loop in your administrator, and/or reach out to the parents.

Immigration Enforcement Policies and Procedures

from Sechin's Dec 16 Monday Message

I've been getting some questions from staff about what we are required to report for immigrant families. Henry M. Jackson High School, in alignment with Everett Public Schools, is committed to ensuring that all students, regardless of immigration status, are entitled to public education. Neither JHS nor EPS will ask for or record a student's or family member's immigration status. If the status is disclosed, no record shall be kept of the disclosure.

In the unlikely event that an immigration agent requests student information, you should refer the request to your administrator. Administrators will not share this information until and unless our legal counsel instructs us to do so. State law places stringent requirements on agents from immigration enforcement agencies before they can access our students.

Summer SIS Blackout for Transition from eSchoolPlus to Synergy

Due to the district's transition from eSchoolPlus to Synergy, the last day that eSchoolPlus will be available for use will be **June 27, 2025**.

Blackout Period: There will be a **blackout period** for all Student Information System (SIS) products from **June 30, 2025,** through **July 17, 2025**. During this time, no SIS products will be accessible.

System Transitions: Several systems are being retired at the same time, including **Cognos** and **Insight**. Other systems are being transitioned to Synergy counterparts:

- Synergy SIS will replace eSchoolPlus
- Synergy OLR will replace PowerSchool Enrollment
- Synergy SE will replace PowerSchool Special Programs
- Synergy Assessment will replace Performance Matters
- TeacherVUE will replace Teacher Access Center and the LMS Gradebook
- ParentVUE will replace Home Access Center and the Parent Portal
- Analytics will replace Insight

Timeline: The Synergy SIS portion is expected to be available to users after **July 18, 2025,** based on training and role. Other portions of the system will come online in the days and weeks following as soon as they are available.

We will provide more information and training as we approach the transition date. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation during this important change.
