Regarding: New CIHS Teachers Application and Courses for 2025-26

Everett Public Schools has established interlocal agreements with local and state colleges to offer College in the High School (CiHS) for some courses taught by qualified high school teaching staff.

For the 2025-26 school year, all <u>new</u> CiHS teachers must apply using the <u>Everett Public Schools CiHS Application</u>. The window for applications varies based on the postsecondary institution as listed below.

Application windows:

- o <u>Edmonds College</u> CiHS application window open through May 30
- o <u>Everett Community College</u> CiHS application window through May 30
- NEW! <u>Central Washington University</u> and <u>Eastern Washington University</u> CiHS programs will also be available for the 2025-26 school year; application windows are open through May 15

To review teachers and courses already approved for CiHS, please review the <u>CiHS Approved Teacher List</u>. A teacher must be approved for <u>each CiHS</u> course. Currently approved teachers and courses do not need to be re-approved for the upcoming school year unless the postsecondary institution has a renewal process.
