WHAT IS EVERETT VIRTUAL ACADEMY?

Everett Virtual Academy (EVA) is an online middle and high school program in partnership with Graduation Alliance. Designed for students who are facing barriers to attending school in-person such as medical or disciplinary reasons, students in EVA complete two classes each month to get back on track.

Students also have the ability to attend virtual and/or inperson meetups to receive extra support. Social meetups are run by Local Advocates and focus on social/emotional needs. These can be virtual or in-person. Study Session meetups are held virtually with the Academic Coaches.

Chromebooks and Wi-Fi hot spots are available to check out from Graduation Alliance at no cost.

Enrollment in this program is by invitation only. Space is very limited.

YOUR FIRST STEPS

- Once you have been referred by your school administrator, the first step is to call the enrollment number: 1-888-615-6115
- Next you will need to connect with your Local Advocate to schedule your first meetup to attend Strong Start Orientation, fill out the enrollment forms, and complete your first assignment.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Grades 6-10
- Referred by a school administrator
- Live within the Everett Public Schools boundaries. EVA does <u>not</u> accept Choice Transfers.
