Everett Public Schools hosts annual job fair on August 12

Aspiring applicants are highly encouraged to apply before the job fair



Everett, WA — Everett Public Schools (EPS) will host its highly anticipated annual job fair on Tuesday, August 12, from 3 to 7 p.m. at the Community Resource Center, located at 3900 Broadway, Everett, WA 98201.

Last year, over 150 applicants attended the event, and 68 job seekers secured positions by the end of the day. This year, the job fair will feature a variety of positions available for the 2025-26 school year, including paraeducators, food and nutrition professionals, bus/van drivers, substitutes, and more.

“We are excited to meet individuals who are passionate about making a positive difference in our community,” said the Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources, Dr. Chad Golden. “This is a unique opportunity for those looking to contribute not only to the growth of our schools but also to the academic and personal growth of our students. On-the-spot interviews and potential job offers will be available, making it easy for candidates to begin their journey with us.”

Applicants are strongly encouraged to apply in advance. Pre-application support will be available from 1 to 3 p.m., providing individualized assistance with resume building, cover letter creation, and application guidance from the Employment Services team. Spanish, Arabic, Russian, and Ukrainian interpreters will be on-site to assist non-English speaking attendees. Interviews will begin promptly at 3 p.m., and hiring managers will be on hand to conduct interviews throughout the event.

EPS is committed to enhancing the diversity of its workforce and building stronger connections with local community organizations and allies across Everett, Mill Creek, and throughout Snohomish County to share employment opportunities with a broad spectrum of job seekers.
