Before being selected as the superintendent for Everett Public Schools and beginning that position on July 1, 2009, Dr. Gary Cohn had been the superintendent of the Port Angeles School District since September 2001. Erickson Trust and the Port Angeles Education Foundation. Dr. Cohn also serves on the Washington Professional Educator Standards Board at the appointment of Gov. Gregoire. Gary and his wife Sue served as 2008 campaign chairs for the United Way in Port Angeles.
