## INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE ENUMCLAW SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 216

WHEREAS, school districts in the State of Washington are authorized by RCW 28A.320 and RCW 39.34, to enter into cooperative agreements for the purchase of various equipment, supplies and services; and

WHEREAS, the Everett School District and the Enumclaw School District desire to reduce their respective costs in purchasing various equipment, supplies and services for use in the school districts; and

WHEREAS, the Enumclaw School District specifically desires to utilize the Board awarded contract entitled "Copiers, Duplicators, and Related Services" to reduce their costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington agrees as follows:

That a joint purchasing agency by and between Everett School District No. 2 and the Enumclaw School District be formed as an interlocal cooperative for the purpose of purchasing various equipment, supplies and services for the duration of the contract for "Copiers, Duplicators, and Related Services".

The Superintendent or designee of Everett School District No. 2 is hereby designated as representative to the joint purchasing agency and the Superintendent or designee is further authorized to execute and implement the requisite agreement or agreements to accomplish this purpose.

The Enumclaw School District will be solely responsible for lease and service obligations for their use of the Everett School District's contracts.

The Everett School District reserves the right to contract independently for any items or services, with or without notice to the Enumclaw School District.
