

**EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2
PUBLIC RECORDS INDEX EXEMPTIONS – SEPTEMBER 2008
RESOLUTION NO. 923**

WHEREAS, the volume of "public records" under Chapter 42.56 RCW developed and accumulated by Everett School District is exceedingly large; and

WHEREAS, the staff time and effort that would be required to assemble and maintain a current index of District public records under RCW 42.56.070(4) is excessive in light of other staff duties related to the District's core educational mission; and

WHEREAS, the District expense and the staff time and effort required to develop and maintain an index of District public records would materially and substantially detract from performance of other duties; and

WHEREAS, in light of the above it would be unduly burdensome to maintain a current index of such District public records, and would interfere with the District's educational operations, without materially improving the District's ability to respond lawfully to requests for public records; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that Everett School District will not maintain an index of public records under RCW 42.56.070(4), but will make available for public inspection and copying all indexes of public records that are maintained for District use.

ADOPTED by the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington at a public meeting held on this 23 day of Sept., 2008, notice of which was given as required by law, the following directors being present and voting therefore.








