RESOLUTION NO. 696

REDUCED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM & REDUCTION OF STAFF

WHEREAS, the anticipated 2000-2001 State operating budget will have a negative impact on the District's ability to maintain its current educational service and support levels; and

WHEREAS, in order to reduce the District expenditures to the level of reasonably anticipated revenues, and to improve operating efficiencies for the benefit of students, it is necessary to make certain reductions in the District's education program, including reductions in certificated, classified, and administrative positions for the 2000-2001 school year;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Everett School District that:

- 1. The Superintendent is directed to develop a reduced educational program for 2000-2001, giving highest priority for retention or creation to positions he/she identifies as necessary to deliver effective programs and services to students; and
- 2. The Superintendent is directed to prepare a 2000-2001 operating budget which restricts expenditures to the level of reasonably anticipated revenues; and
- 3. The superintendent is directed to take such action as may be required by law to notify administrative and classified employees who will be affected by reduction of positions; and
- 4. The Superintendent is authorized to make such other plans to implement this reduced educational program as are necessary to comply with the legal obligations of the District.
