

## AUTHORIZATION OF FACSIMILE SIGNATURE

### Board Resolution No. 690

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 86, Laws of 1969, as codified in RCW 39.62 authorizes the use of facsimile signatures by any public officer in lieu of a manual signature to execute any "public security" or any "instrument of payment"; and

**WHEREAS**, the statute further requires that before any authorized officer may use a facsimile signature plate or stamp, he/she must file a manual signature with the Secretary of State, duly certified while under oath; and

**WHEREAS**, Peggy Churn and Jeffrey S. Riddle, Superintendents/Secretaries of the Board, have filed Certificate of Manual Signature, duly certified under oath, with the Auditor of Snohomish County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the facsimile plate or stamp, as imprinted below, for Peggy Churn and Jeffrey S. Riddle, Superintendents/Secretaries, be accepted for use in lieu of a manual signature on any public security or any instrument of pay of Everett School District No. 2.
