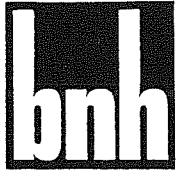


RE: Evergreen Middle School New Construction and Modernization
