AUTHORIZATION TO EMPLOY TRS PLAN I RETIREES AS SUBSTITUTE
PRINCIPALS FOR THE 2000 - 2001 SCHOOL YEAR

This is a resolution from the Everett School District No. 2 Board of Directors petitioning the State Board of Education for approval of an authorization to employ TRS Plan I retirees as substitute principals.


WHEREAS, the Everett School District, Snohomish County, Washington, is a first class district under the statutes of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the legislature will allow TRS Plan I retirees to work 840 hours (an additional 315 hours per school year beyond the 525 hours currently allowed) without affecting their retirement benefit, and;

WHEREAS, as the District exhausts its list of available and qualified substitutes it desires to hire TRS Plan I retirees for administrative substitute services to address the shortage of qualified and available substitutes;


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Superintendent of the Everett School District, Everett, Washington, is authorized to hire TRS Plan I retirees for an additional 45 days (315 hours) of employment beyond the 75 days (525 hours) currently permitted as the District exhausts its list of available and qualified substitutes in the 2000 - 2001 school year.


