RESOLUTION NO. 480

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, declaring the need for collection of school mitigation fees as authorized by Snohomish County.

WHEREAS, Snohomish County on February 27, 1991 adopted Ordinance 91-027 which created a new Title 26C to the Snohomish County Code; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provides for school adequacy standards and provides for an impact fee program for public school facilities; and

WHEREAS, current projections of future school enrollments indicate a substantial increase in enrollments through 1997; and

WHEREAS, this indicator of positive enrollment growth is of sufficient magnitude to warrant participation in the Snohomish County program.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington

- 1. The Everett School District will pursue recertification under Title 26C of the Snohomish County Code
- 2. The Administration is authorized to inform Snohomish County of the District's findings that unhoused students may occur over the ensuing five years,
- 3. The Administration is authorized to present to the County the analyses and methodology developed to show the level of inadequate capacity and to work with each jurisdiction in meeting the requirements for mitigation as specified under their respective ordinances and titles.
