RESOLUTION NO 290

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 289 of this date the Board of Directors of the Everett School District (the "District") has elected to terminate the 1980-82 District-Everett Education Association collective bargaining agreement effective at the end of the 1980-81 school year, and

WHEREAS, by the aforesaid election the District will not be obligated to allocate 1981-82 revenues to the salary increases otherwise applicable.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the District as follows:

- 1. Resolution No. 286 providing for a 1981-82 Reduced Educational Program is hereby amended as follows:
- a. The course offerings at the high schools shall be restored to a 6-period day.
- b. Authorized 1981-82 FTE certificated staff shall be increased from 527.3 to 577.3 as provided in the Revised Certificated Staffing Plan (6/29/81) attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof.
- 2. The Superintendent is directed to identify and promptly notify those staff members entitled to reemployment by reason of the restoration of certificated positions as provided herein.
- 3. The Superintendent is further directed to prepare and submit to the Board his recommendations for such further restorations of programs and staff for the 1981-82 school year as may be compatible with the educational needs of the District's students and the funds which can reasonably be anticipated to be available for said school year.
