WHEREAS, as of this date salary schedules and other applicable terms of employment for the 1983-84 school year have not be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. Individual employment contracts shall be issued forthwith to all nonsupervisory certificated staff members entitled to an offer of employment for the 1983-84 school year;
- 2. The Board hereby adopts the 1982-83 nonsupervisory certificated employee salary schedules on an interim basis for application to the 1983-84 school year exactly as said schedules were applied in 1982-83 that is, without additional salary, experience or educational credits and;
- 3. The Superintendent is hereby directed to cause to be delivered forthwith to all nonsupervisory certificated personnel to be offered employment for the 1983-84 school year a completed contract in the form attached hereto and consistent with the interim 1983-84 salary schedules as they apply to each contract recipient.
