## EMERGENCY AT EISENHOWER MIDDLE SCHOOL

WHEREAS, a fire occurred on October 3, 1985, at the Everett School District's Eisenhower Middle School; and

WHEREAS, the fire destroyed a significant portion of the school which must be cleaned up, demolished and/or repaired without delay; and

WHEREAS, the condition of the school is likely to result in physical injury to persons or school district property in the absence of prompt remedial action; and

WHEREAS, compliance with the regular competitive bidding process would prolong these dangerous conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington that pursuant to RCW 28A.58.135, an emergency is hereby declared and the Everett School District shall immediately contract, under the emergency provisions of competitive bidding statutes, for the demolition, clean up and/or repair of the Eisenhower Middle School and thereby alleviate the risk of injury to persons or school district property.
