

SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FUNDING

RESOLUTION NO. 374

WHEREAS, the 1987 legislature adopted House Joint Resolution No. 4220 which submits a constitutional amendment to be approved by the voters in the fall of 1987 for the establishment of a tax on property to be deposited in the common school construction fund; and

WHEREAS, the current needs for the Everett School District as well as the state indicate that without such an additional amount of funds to provide a stable source of revenue to the common school construction funds, our district will have to eliminate or delay indefinitely major renovations for buildings to provide needed instructional space or will be forced to ask local voters to support the entire cost of such facilities at a higher cost; and

WHEREAS, the passage of this constitutional amendment will provide a permanent school construction fund which will not only provide for the immediate school construction needs but will also provide a permanent school fund which in future years will generate sufficient interest to supplement the timber sale monies in such a way as to provide an ongoing and continual support of matching construction funds for school districts in the State of Washington, including the Everett School District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Everett School District No. 2 endorses House Joint Resolution No. 4220 and urges the voters of this district as well as voters throughout Snohomish County and the state to support this constitutional amendment to provide for a permanent and cost effective solution to the common school construction needs of school districts in the state.
