COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

between

FEDERAL WAY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 210

and

SCHOOL DISTRICT'S LISTED IN ATTACHMENT "A"

Whereas, the undersigned, Federal Way School District No. 210, and School District's listed in attachment "A" desire to form a purchasing cooperative to purchase food and commodity processing for their respective district's at the lowest possible price pursuant to the Inter-Governmental Cooperative Act as now or hereafter amended in Chapter 39.34 RCW, and

Whereas, it is believed by the undersigned that formation of the cooperative hereafter established will be in the best interest of all districts involved.

Now, therefore, it is hereby agreed as follows:

- 1. The purpose of this cooperative shall be to purchase food and commodity processing of any type and nature whatsoever for any and all schools and school districts that are part of the cooperative at the lowest possible prices.
- Membership: The school districts executing this agreement shall be known as member districts, and shall be entitled to the rights and privileges set forth for member districts as provided hereinafter.
- 3. Organization and Operation: The cooperative will be operated jointly with the administrative duties (i.e. calling for bids, awarding bids, etc.) being performed by the Federal Way School District Purchasing Department and the policies adopted by the Federal Way School District's Board of Directors.

Food and commodity processing selected for joint purchase shall be on a voluntary basis as agreed from time to time by member districts. Each member district shall have one representative (as appointed by the Superintendent of the represented districts) as a voting member of the cooperative.

The cost of running the cooperative will be shared equally by all member districts, i.e. advertisements for bids, etc.

Each member district will be responsible for payment of their own invoices resulting from the purchase of food and commodity processing under this cooperative and shall do so directly to the supplier, billing same within the payment terms agreed to.

This cooperative shall continue in perpetuity unless dissolved by law or by agreement of member districts.

Cooperative Purchasing Agreement - Page 2

Any member of this cooperative may withdraw from participation by serving written notice to the administrative district of the cooperative ninety (90) days prior to the intended date of withdrawal.

Additional members may join the cooperative upon written request to the cooperative by the Superintendent of the requesting district and the acceptance of the request by a simple majority of the existing member districts in the cooperative at the time of the request.
