RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2

Snohomish County, Washington

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, are operating a community college known as Everett Junior College, under authority of Chapter 198, Laws of Washington, 1961; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2 have previously authorized by resolution a petty cash fund in the amount of \$300.00 and a revolving fund in the amount of \$2000.00.

WHEREAS, the demands on the petty cash fund have increased to the extent that \$300.00 is no longer adequate for this fund and the amount of \$2000.00, which was originally set up in the revolving fund, has proved to be inadequate to take care of all of the tuition and fees refunds immediately following the period of registration

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION I. That the amount of the petty cash fund be increased from \$300.00 to \$500.00.

SECTION II. That the amount of the revolving fund be increased from \$2000.00 to \$3000.00.
