

RESOLUTION NO. 25

WHEREAS, Everett School District No. 2 was required to close all schools of the District January 13, 18 and 19, and all schools excepting Everett Junior College on January 20, 24, 25, 26 and 27, and Silver Lake School January 10 and 23, 1950, due to snow storms and cold weather that prevailed through these days, and,

WHEREAS, No time or opportunity has enabled the District to make up this attendance, and,

WHEREAS, Section 7, Chapter 28, Laws of 1933 provides that the District may request accredited apportionment on basis of average daily attendance when schools are unavoidably closed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2 respectfully request the State Superintendent and the County Superintendent of Schools to allow attendance for days lost on the basis of average daily attendance in the District for the school year 1949-1950.
