

RESOLUTION NO. 70

WHEREAS, Everett School District No. 2 desires to build a Junior High School in the area between Beverly Lane and Highway 99 south of the Windmill; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire the following described property, to-wit:

Commencing at West quarter corner of Section 7, Township 28 N. Range 5 E.W.M.; thence South  $89^{\circ} 16' 44''$  East along the East and West center line of said Section 7 for 20 feet; thence South  $1^{\circ} 21' 48''$  West for 604.15 feet to point of beginning; thence continue South  $1^{\circ} 21' 48''$  West for 561.67 feet; thence South  $88^{\circ} 14' 40''$  East for 441.45 feet; thence in a northeasterly direction 661.06 feet more or less to a point 793.93 feet from point of beginning; thence North  $88^{\circ} 14' 40''$  West 793.93 feet to point of beginning, situate in Snohomish County, Washington; Containing 7.96 acres.

and

WHEREAS, the owners refuse to sell same at any reasonable price, the Board having offered \$16,250.00 for same; and it appearing that it is impossible to arrive at a satisfactory settlement except by condemnation;

BE IT RESOLVED that C. W. Jordan, attorney for the Everett School District No. 2 be and he hereby is instructed to commence condemnation proceedings against the owners of the above described property.
