

RESOLUTION NO. 75

WHEREAS, School District No. 24 and its successor School District No. 2 of Snohomish County, Washington has held title to the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, Township 29 North Range 5 EMM, which is also known as 13th and Oakes Field, since August 18, 1924 and,

WHEREAS, The East portion of this property described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 18 Broadway Land Co.'s first addition to the City of Everett, thence in a Westerly direction on the South line of Lot 18 extended for 39.95 feet thence in a Northerly direction parallel to Lombard Avenue to a point 49.82 feet from the Northwest corner of Lot 24, Block 217 Powers First Addition to the City of Everett on the North line of Lot 24 extended thence 45.82 feet to the NW corner of said lot 24 thence in a Southerly direction to the true place of beginning:

has been used by adjoining property owners for placement of garages, woodsheds and as an alley way for many years, and,

WHEREAS, the land described is not needed by School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that land described be declared surplus and that sale be made to adjoining property owners at prices appraised and that a 20 foot alley on west portion of described land be dedicated for public use.

3. Does not plan and promote drama activities sufficiently well.
